



Home School Agreement

At Sunny Bank Primary School we will:

- teach a broad and balanced curriculum
- encourage high standards in work and behaviour
- set, mark and monitor homework on a regular basis
- care for your child's safety in all school activities
- take account of your child's individual needs
- keep you regularly informed about your child's academic attainment, progress and curriculum coverage
- work in partnership with you and other agencies to help your child achieve their full potential

As Parents/Carers we will:

- fulfil our legal obligation to ensure our child attends school regularly and notify the school if our child is unable to attend
- ensure our child arrives at school on time and properly prepared for the school day which includes the correct uniform (PE/swimming kit, appropriate footwear, hair and book bags if appropriate)
- keep the school informed of anything that may affect our child's behaviour, learning or attendance
- make every effort to attend open evenings
- ensure our child completes homework or home learning activities as appropriate, on time
- support the school's approach to eSafety and will not upload or add any pictures, video or text that could upset, offend or threaten the safety of any member of the school community
- work in partnership with the school to help our child achieve their full potential
- make sure our child does not wear jewellery or bring expensive items to school including toys and footballs
- will ensure my child follows the school's behaviour policy and understand the importance of being well behaved at school
- ensure my child understands the importance of school and encourage them to value education

As a pupil I will (Code of Conduct):

- respect all adults and other children in the school
- listen carefully and to be the best I can be
- ask if I need to borrow something
- behave sensibly and move calmly around the school

Together, we will work to ensure the development of a positive and responsible citizen through a caring and challenging learning community with high expectations where all can achieve their full potential.

- A. I understand the importance of informing school of any changes to phone numbers and contact details (including email addresses) in case of an emergency.

- B. I understand that my child may be released to Children and Families Social Services and/or Kent police if they are not collected from school by an approved adult at the end of the school day.

- C. As a parent/guardian I agree to support and uphold school's policies, practices and procedures and to communicate and work well with school to further my child's education, development and well-being.

I understand that this form is valid from the date signed until my child is no longer on the school roll and that it is my responsibility to inform school of any changes to the above or if I wish to withdraw my consent to any of the above. My child will be asked to sign the form from Year 3.
