Childcare can make life better for you and your children

The Facts

Since September 2017, the Government have rolled out 30 hours of funded childcare for those who are entitled to it.

KCC will fund any eligible child attending a Kent provision regardless of where they live.

For a child to get free 30hr early education and childcare:

A family qualifies for the extended entitlement if both parents are working (or the sole parent in a lone family is working) and each parent earns, on average, a minimum equivalent to 16 hours (National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage) and less than £100K a year.

If you meet the criteria, you are entitled to up to 30 hours free childcare.

Sunny Bank Primary School Nursery Admissions Policy for 3/4 year olds

Children are generally admitted to the nursery at the beginning of the term after their 3rd birthday, in September, January and April. The school organises admissions to the nursery.

Birthdays between April 1st – Aug 31st September admission

Birthdays between Sept1st – Dec 31st January admission

Birthdays between Jan 1st – Mar 31st April admission

If there are vacancies children may be admitted after the mid-term holiday in Nov, Feb and June

When the nursery is oversubscribed, the waiting list will be prioritised according to the following criteria.

1. A small number of places will be offered to children with special education, social, emotional or medical needs, as assessed by the multi-agency Early Years meeting
2. Nearness of the child's home to the school- with those children living nearer being given priority.

We offer 6, 30 hour places:

Places will be offered in order of date of birth (oldest children first) and subject to availability of places.
