In term 6, we will be focusing on ensuring we have understood and used all features within a range of types of writing. We will start by focusing on a narrative with speech. We will then move on to a persuasive speech using formal language. The children will then have the opportunity to explore a piece of writing that interests them.



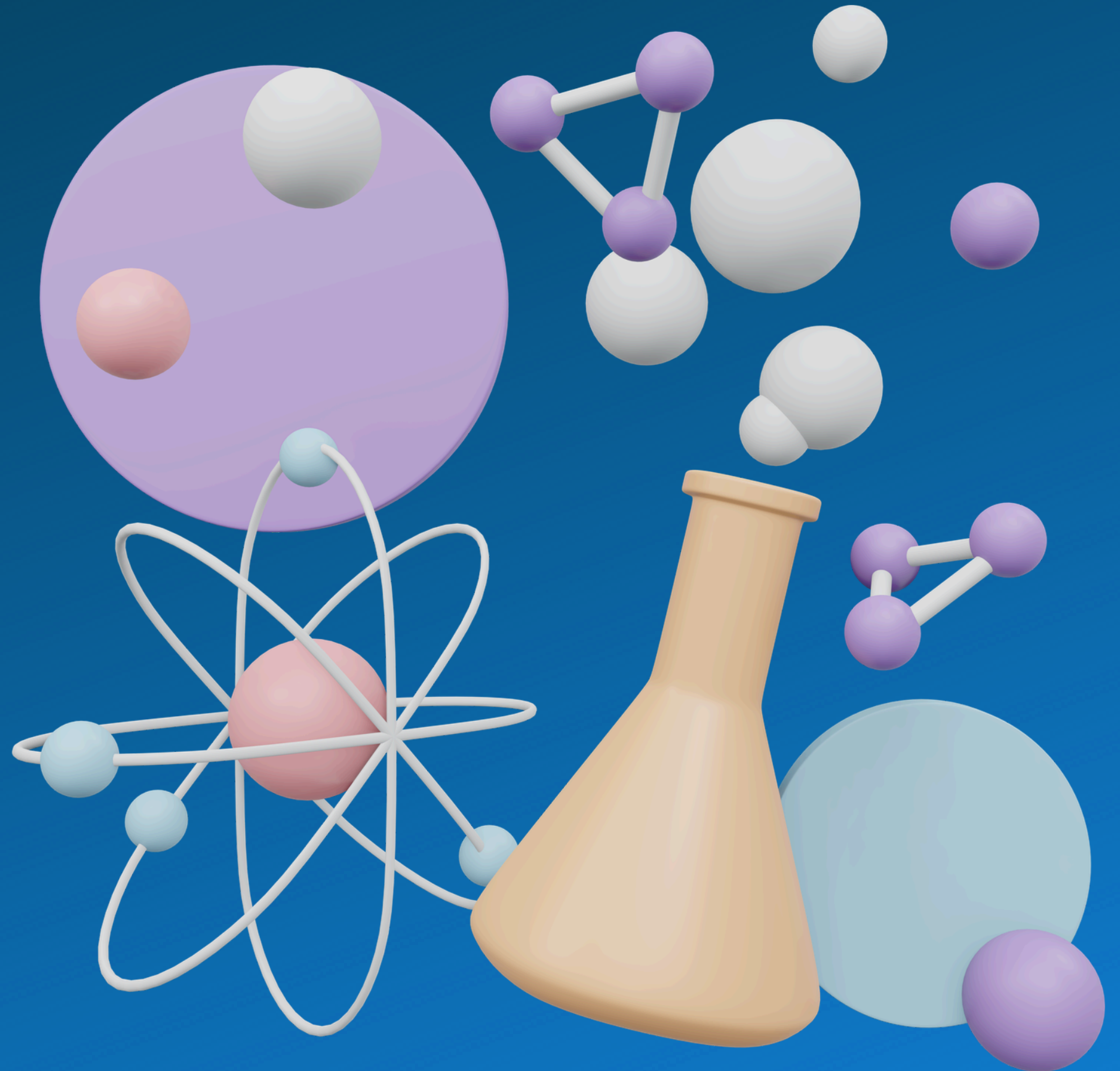
Maths

This term we will work on developing the children's understanding of maths in the real world. Through an entrepreneur project, children will have the opportunity to learn all about earning, expenditure, profit and loss. They will be attempting to 'make money grow' with the Virgin Media make £5 Grow Challenge. Alongside this, children will also learn about income and expenditure in the home. Children will of course, continue to develop their oracy skills through talk for maths; this will enable them to further strengthen their reasoning and problem-solving skills so that they become more confident in making connections within and across mathematical concepts.



Science

This term in science, pupils will bring together knowledge from previous units while developing their enquiry skills. They will investigate how light and UV pass through different materials by testing a range of sunglasses, using their results to decide which pair offers the best protection.



Topic

This term our topic focus will be Geography and children will learn all about natural resources. They will consider where in the world natural resources are produced and how we can protect the planet.



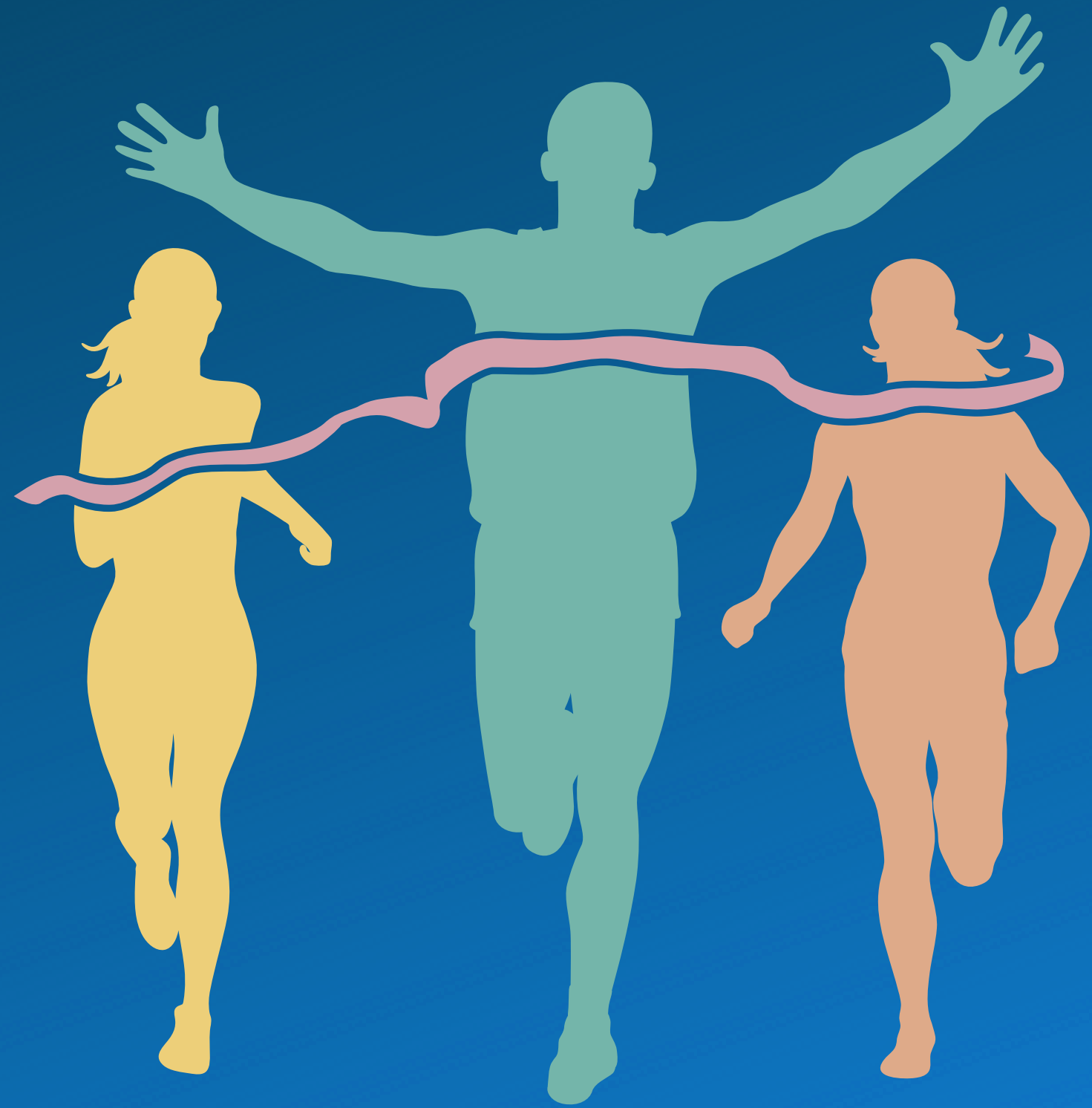
Art

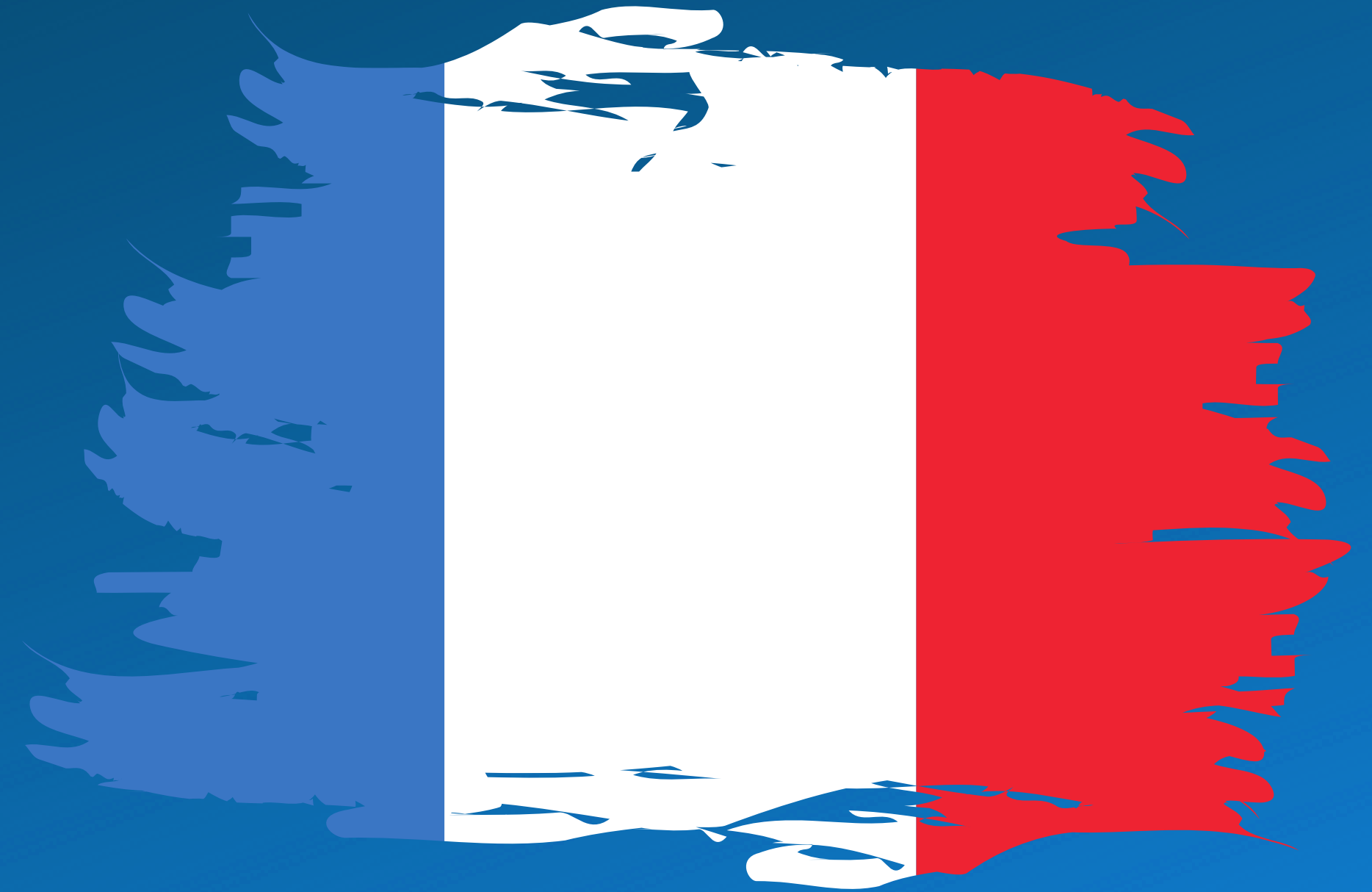
Computing
