LITERACY

In Term 6 the children will be exploring a new book called 'Winnie the Witch'. They will be writing character descriptions to describe Winnie's appearance and personality, using adjectives to make their writing exciting. The children will be writing setting descriptions based around the pictures which they will see in the story. Not only will the children be writing creatively, they will also be using their learning to allow them to re-write some of the stories we learn about.



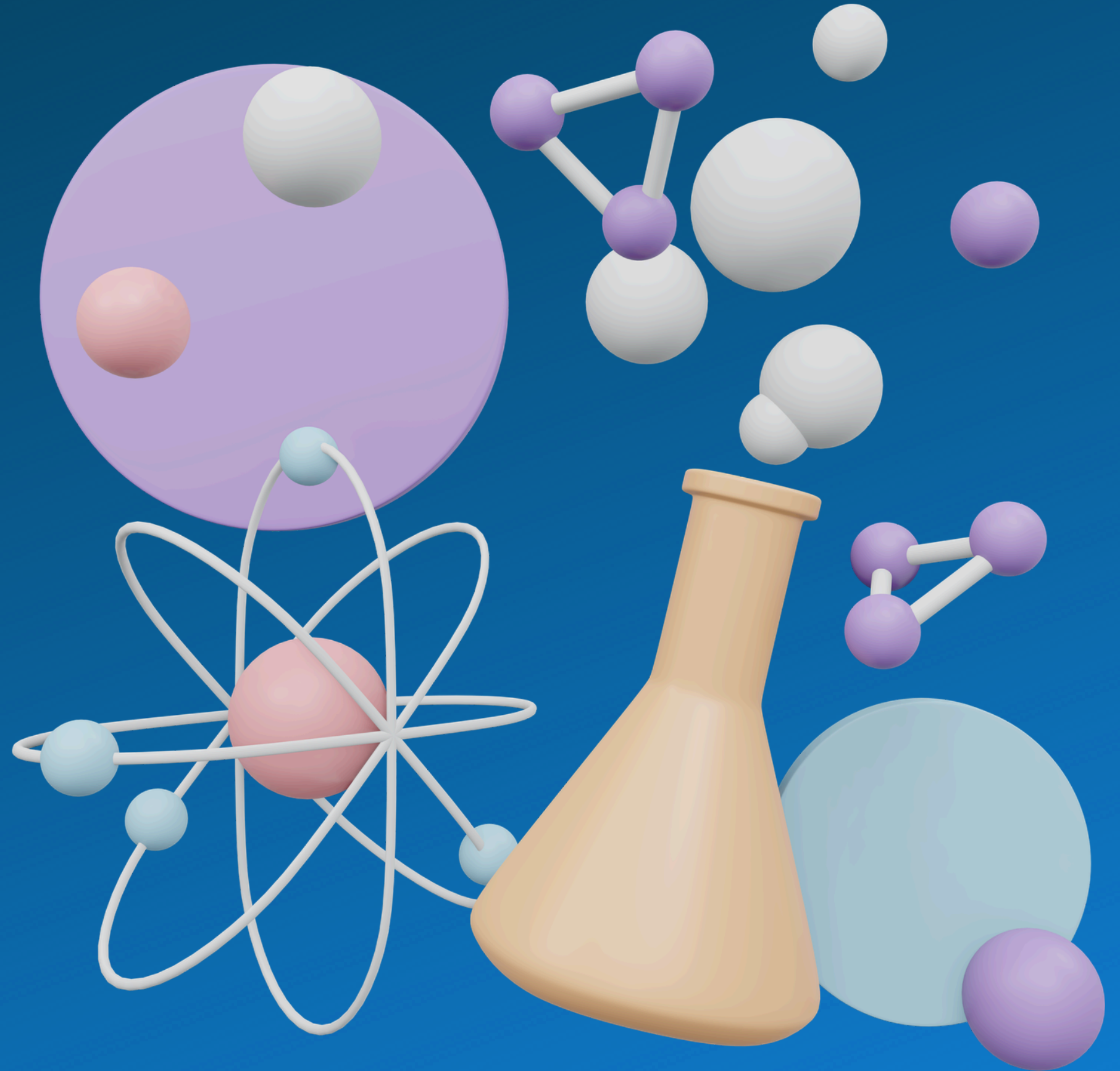
Maths

In Maths the children will be working with numbers up to 100 and using these numbers to solve a range of addition and subtraction calculations. The children will be learning more about fractions and will find a half, a quarter and three quarters of an amount. The children will learn all about telling the time to o' clock and half past. They will also learn how knowing their 5 times table can help them when telling the time!



Science

Year One will be learning how to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made during the topic 'Everyday Materials'. Along with, how to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. We will also be looking into how changes happen during the different seasons



Topic

Our theme this term is 'Eco Warriors'. The children will learn more about their local area and consider how we can reduce the amount of litter and pollution. The children will learn how to complete different surveys and analyse their data.



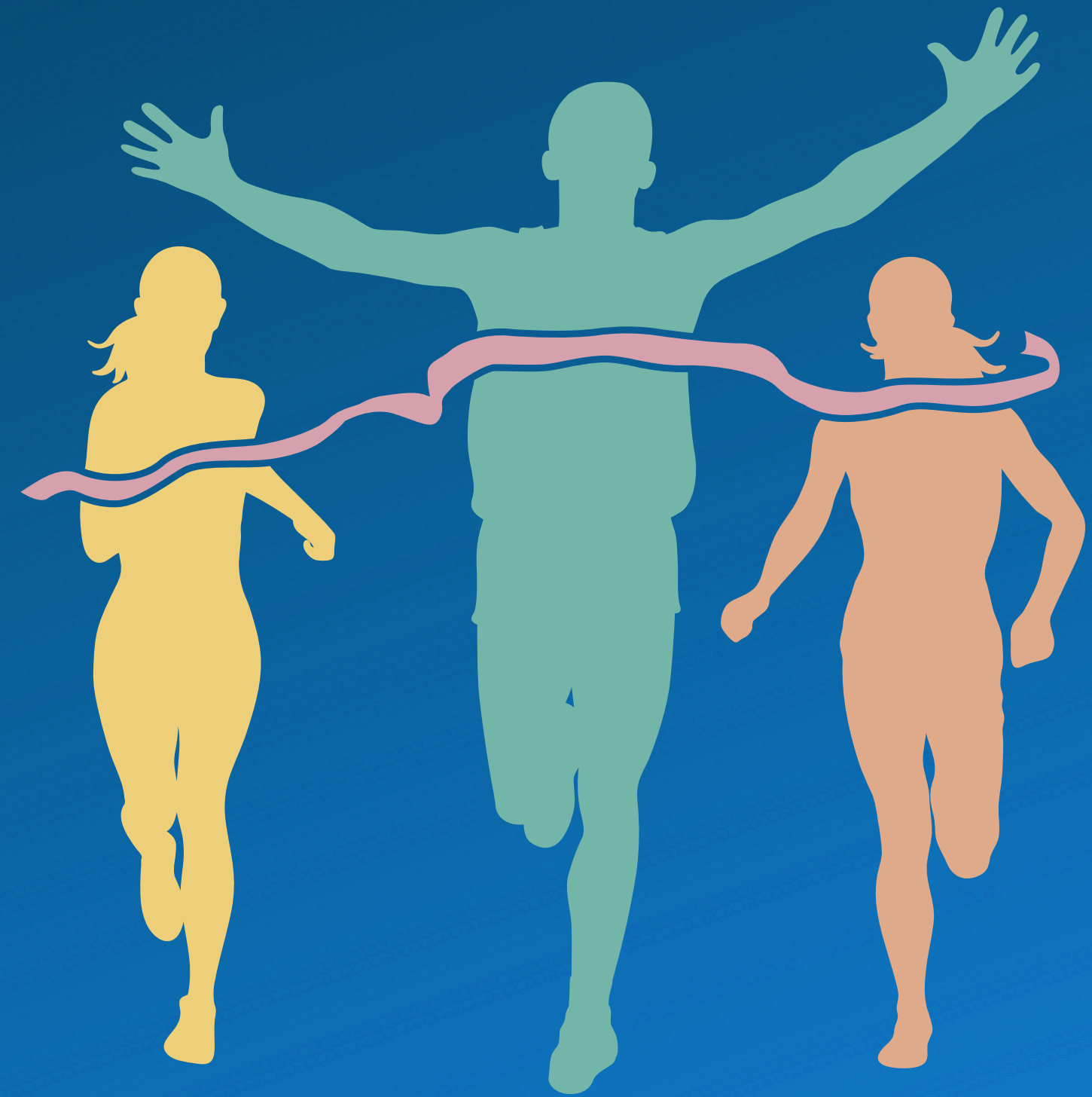
Art
