



# LITERACY



In Literacy this term, we will be using the text 'Guess who is coming for dinner' to support and inspire our writing. We will be covering a range of writing genres including invitation, menu, a review and instructions.



# Maths

This term we will continue to develop children's oracy skills through talk for maths; this will enable children to further strengthen their reasoning and problem-solving skills so that they become more confident in making connections within and across mathematical concepts. We will also place a strong emphasis on those children needing support to consolidate their times table knowledge. Concept wise, we will continue our learning on multiplication and division and then moving on to length and perimeter. There will also be a strong focus on arithmetic, where children will be given the opportunity to practise the four operations weekly.

Reading – 30 mins per day



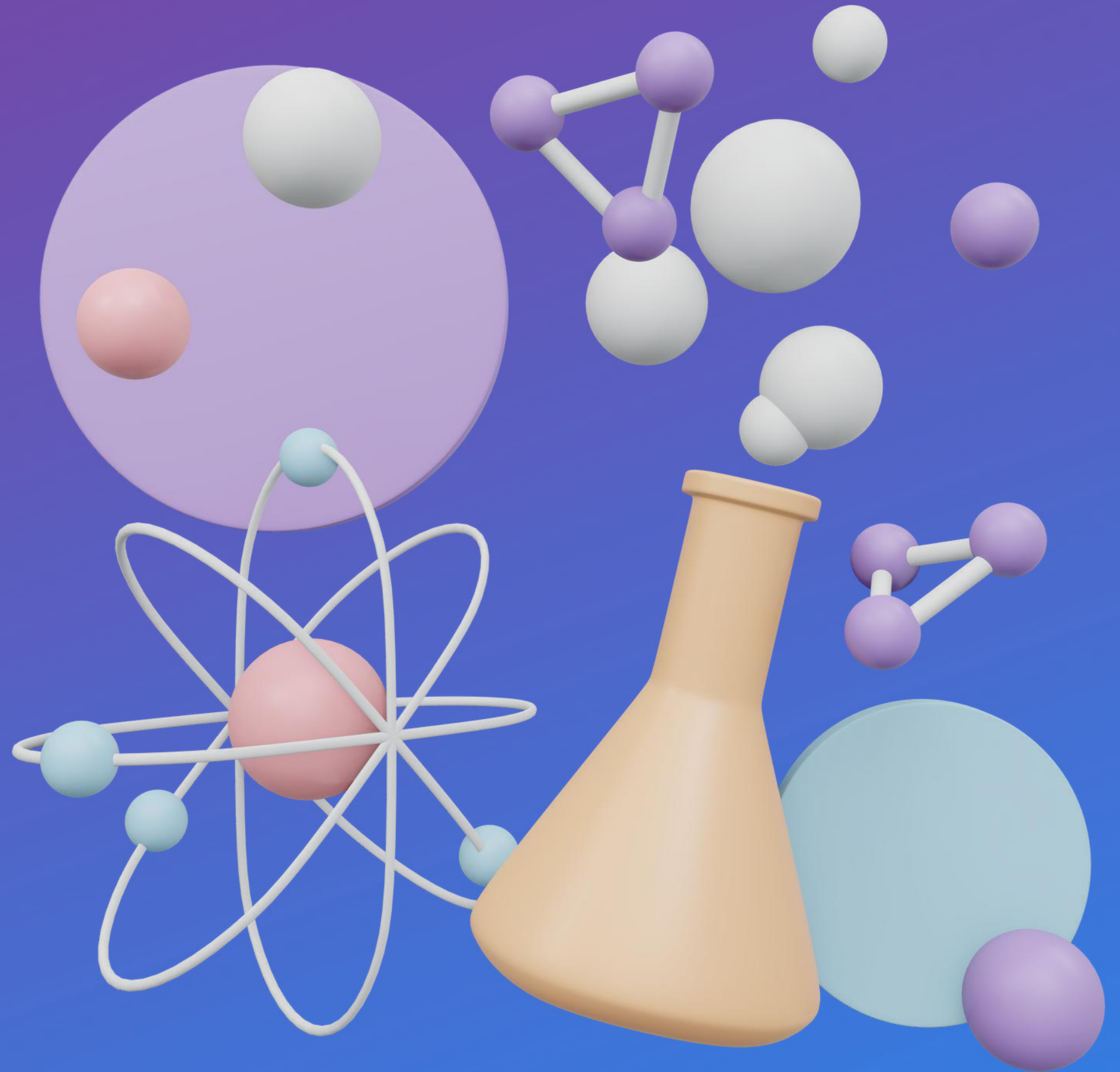

# Science

Our topic in science this term is states of matter. The class will explore the differences between solids, liquids and gases and they will classify objects and identify their properties.

Hawthorn class will be learning how to play the ukelele. Following simple rhythms and techniques.



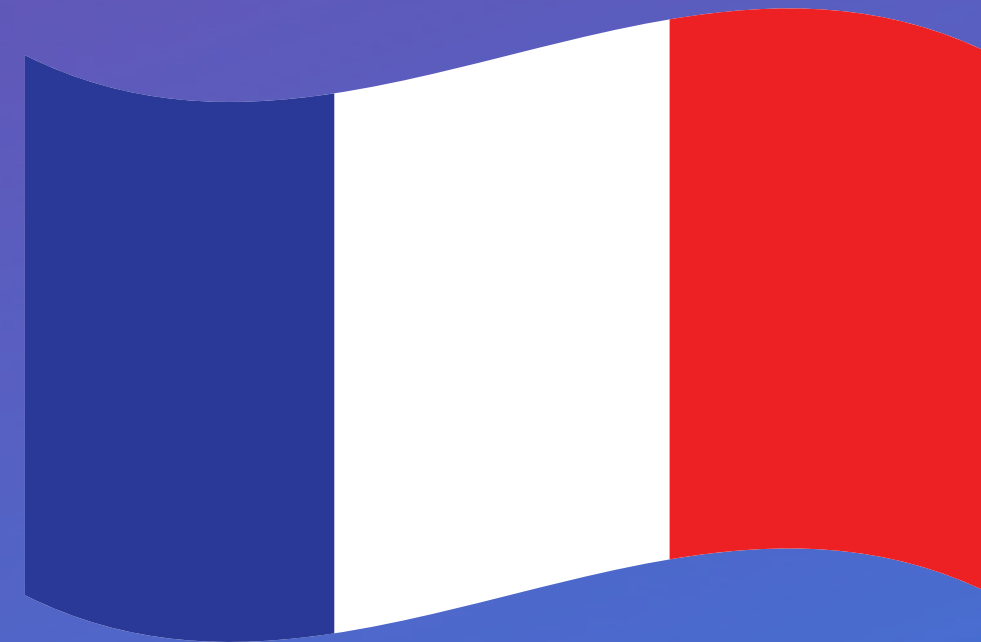
# Art
