





# LITERACY



In Literacy this term, Juniper class will be using the book 'Toro Toro' as inspiration for their writing. We will be experimenting with levels of formality in a newspaper report, putting our figurative language learning in to practise in a descriptive narrative and finally writing a setting description.



# Maths

This term we will continue to develop children's oracy skills through talk for maths; this will enable children to further strengthen their reasoning and problem-solving skills so that they become more confident in making connections within and across mathematical concepts. We will also place a strong emphasis on those children needing support to consolidate their times table knowledge. Concept wise, we will start the term by developing our skills in multiplication and division, followed by knowledge and skills within fractions. The children will continue to develop their arithmetic skills.

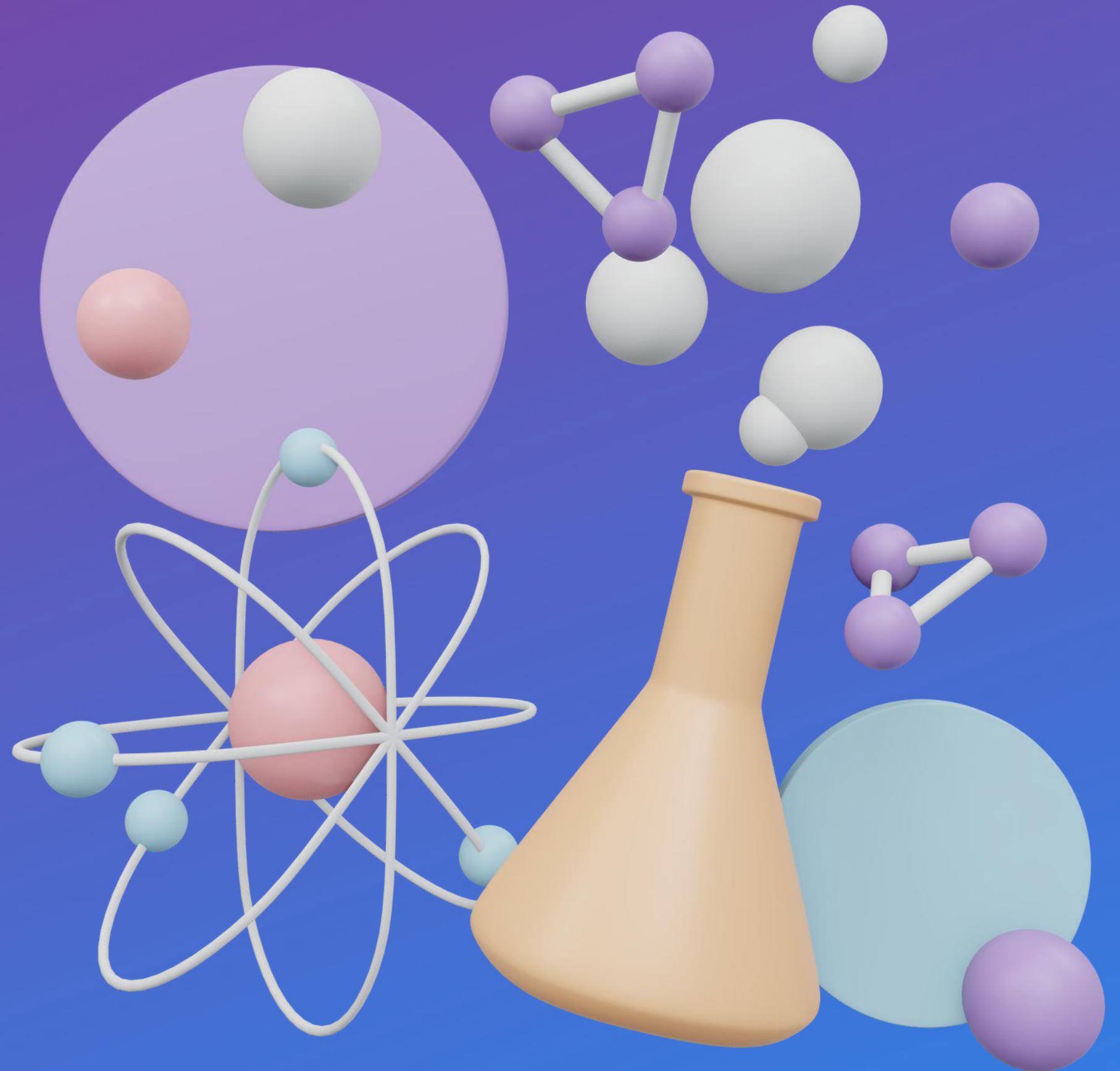

# Science

The children will study Earth and Space; They will study why we have seasons and how these are linked to the tilt of the Earth, the sun as a source of light and we will spend some time looking at the history of space travel.



# Topic

This term we will be exploring the United Kingdom. We will think about geographical features of the UK, think about the counties, towns and cities as well as coasts and seas around the UK.



# Art

In art we will be exploring street art through a range of mediums. We will look at what people think of the term 'graffiti' and how this can be used to improved public area.

In PE this term, Juniper class will be swimming on a Friday. Please ensure your child has a one-piece swimsuit and a towel.

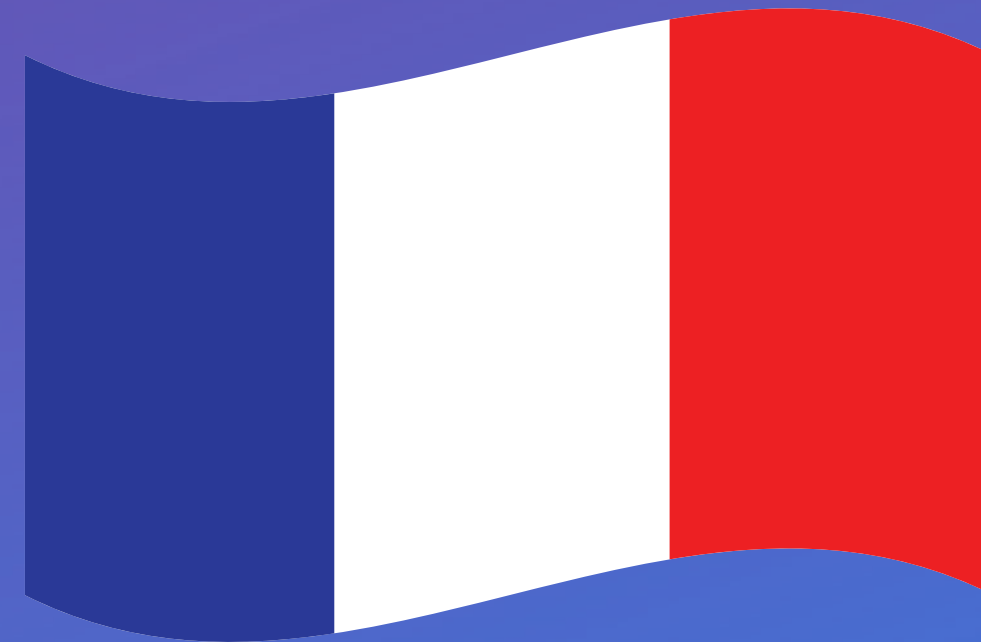
# Music
