



TERM 3

LITERACY



In Literacy this term, Oak class will be using the book 'Floodland' to inspire their writing. We will write a setting description, a narrative and a non-chronological report. We will use the text to source vocabulary and key ideas and writerly techniques. Our GPAS focus on a Monday each week will ensure that children have the knowledge and understanding required for a particular piece of writing, they will then be encouraged to include this learning into their writing each day.

Maths

This term we will continue to develop children's oracy skills through talk for maths; this will enable children to further strengthen their reasoning and problem-solving skills so that they become more confident in making connections within and across mathematical concepts. We will also place a strong emphasis on those children needing support to consolidate their times table knowledge. Concept wise, we will start the term by finalising and consolidating our understanding of fractions, followed by measurement, ratio and then percentages. There will also be a strong focus on arithmetic, where children will be given the opportunity to practise the four operations weekly.

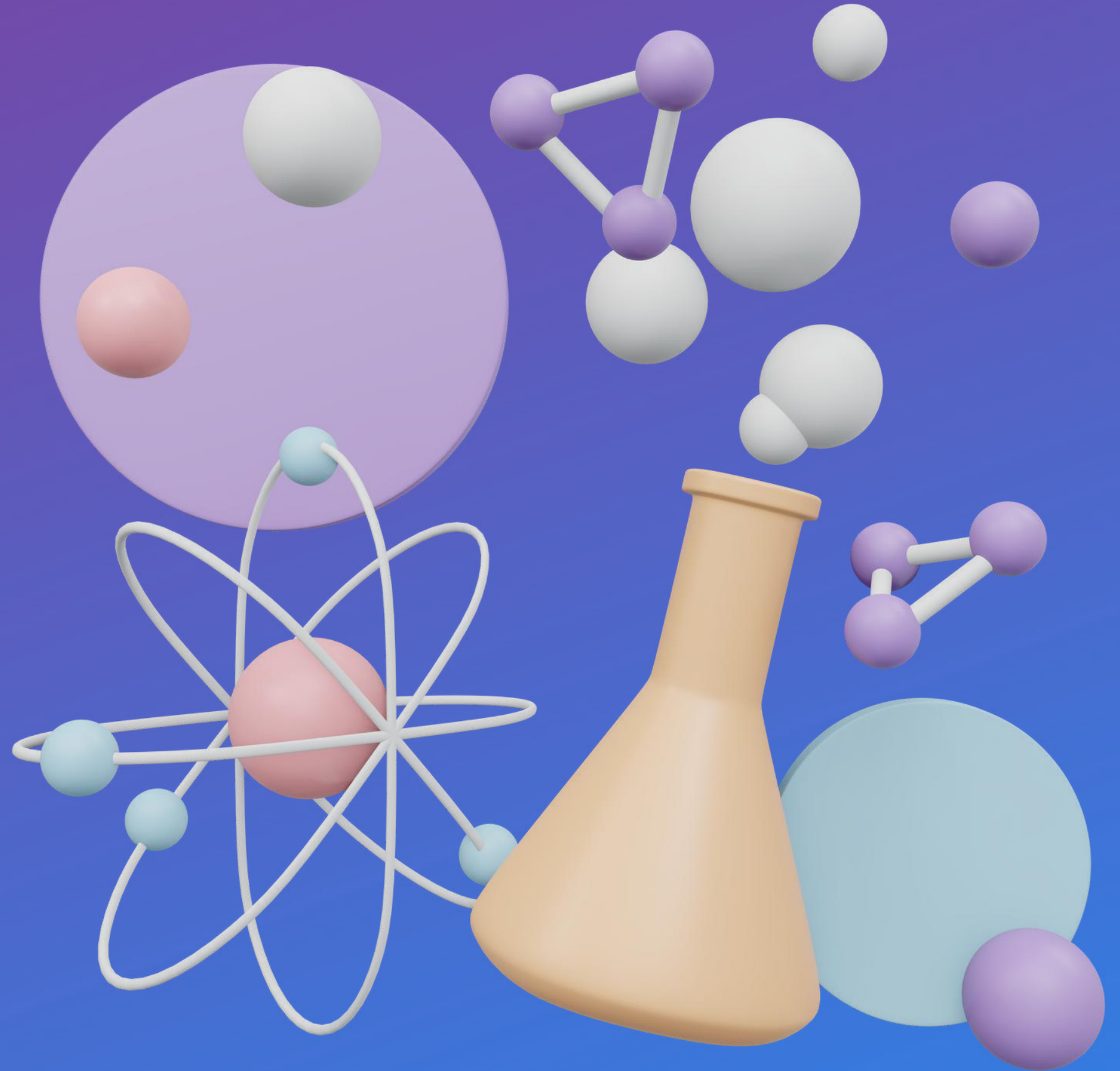
Special days and enrichment:

Science

This term we will be using our prior learning of identifying the key characteristics of animals and plants, to classification. Children will learn all about how to classify living things using the Linnaean method.



Topic

This term children will learn about migration and how and why people have migrated and settled over time, across the world. Children will learn what a refugee is and will explore what it might feel like to be a migrant or a refugee what migrate. They will also learn how climate change affects migration.



Art

Our focus this term will be DT and children will learn about sourcing food from around the world. We will also learn about food miles as well as considering the seasonality of foods. The children will also have the opportunity to try some seasonal soups.



PE

In PE this term, Oak class will be doing leadership skills for indoor PE and rounders for outdoor PE.

Leadership skills will involve looking at what it means to be a team, lead a team and lead effective play which will help with our OPAL introduction.



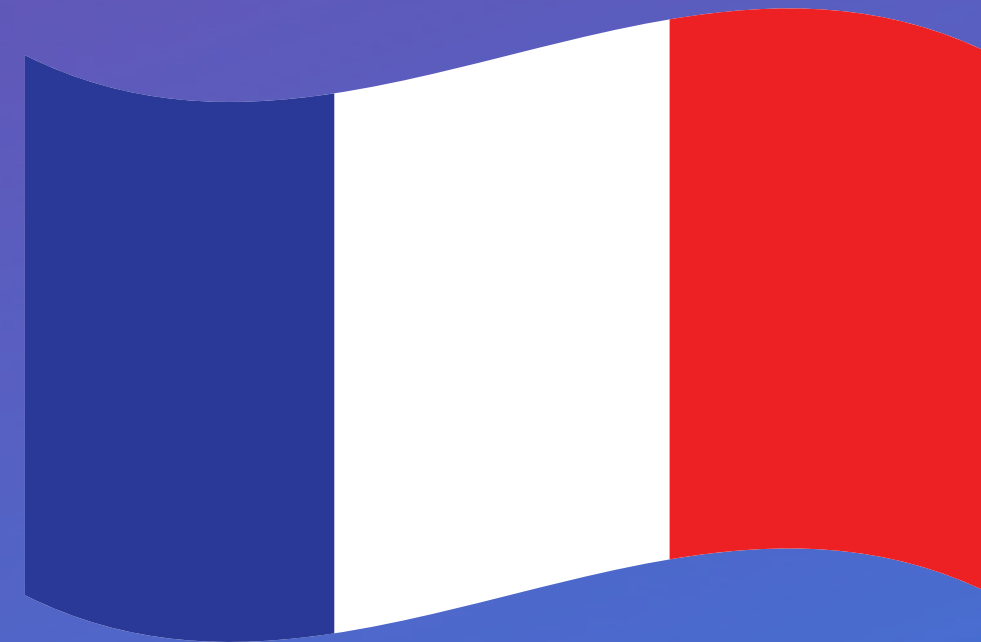
Music

In this unit, pupils will explore pulse work in 3-time, learn to sing the song as a round, learn about texture in music, and compare music with different textures. They will create their own pieces using given rhythms and chords, working from stick notation.



French

Children will learn how to read nouns to describe places they like to go. They will develop their understanding of positive and negative opinion and will continue to develop their speaking and listening skills with peers in back-and-forth conversations.



Computing

This term children will be learning all about data and information spreadsheets. They will collect, input and store data using spreadsheets and will learn how to sort, filter, analyse and use data within a spreadsheet by creating formulas, charts and graphs.



RE

This term we will be describing what Christians mean about humans being 'made in the image of God' and being 'fallen', giving examples. We will learn about some Christian and Humanist values. Children will be encouraged to express their own ideas about some big moral concepts, such as fairness or honesty comparing them with the ideas of others they have studied.
