

Maths

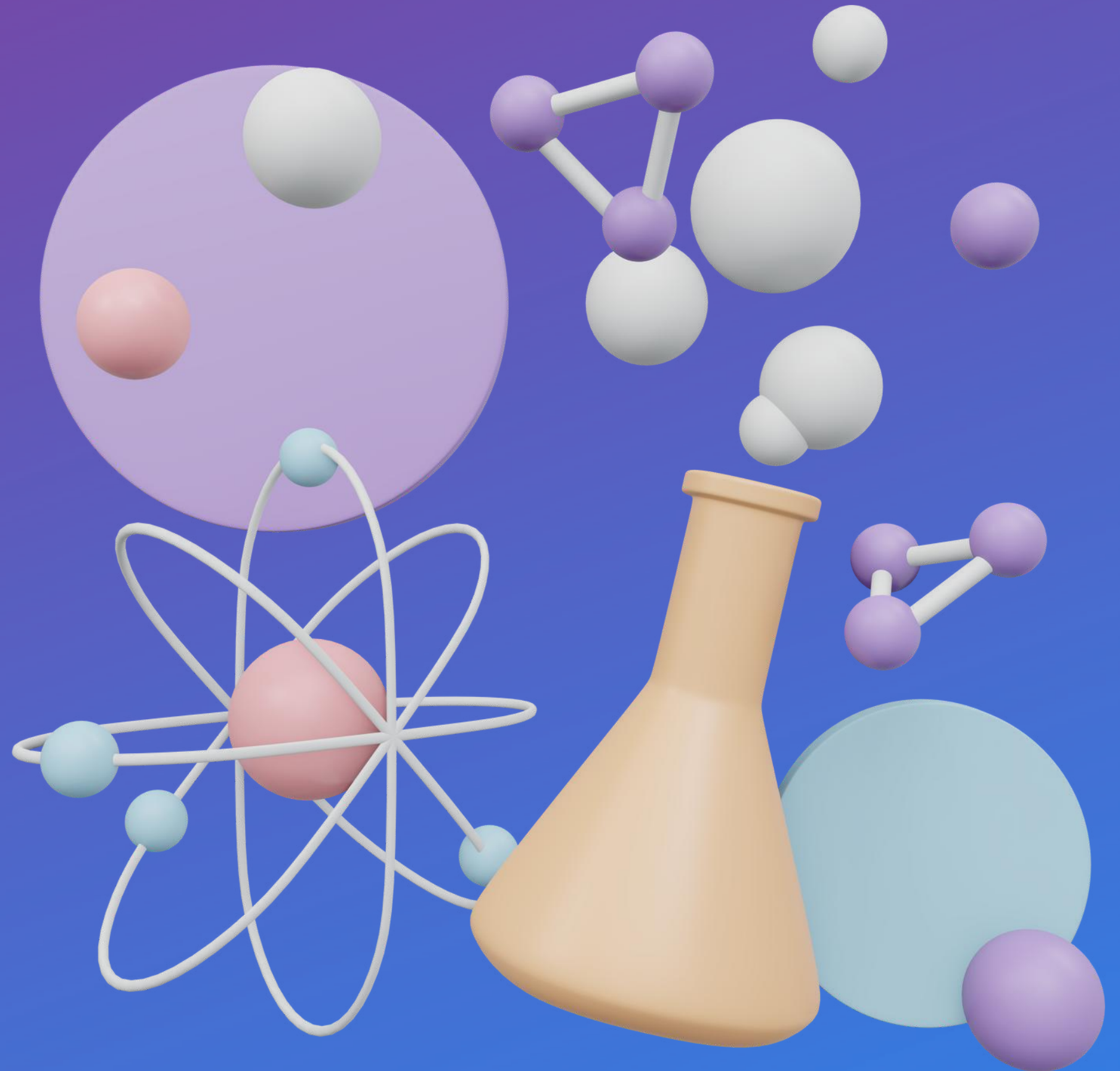
In Term 2 we will continue to practice our knowledge of number and work on our number formation. We will continue using practical resources, such as numicon and tens frames, to support us when solving addition and subtraction calculations.

We will also be learning the names of 2D and 3D shapes and comparing their properties.



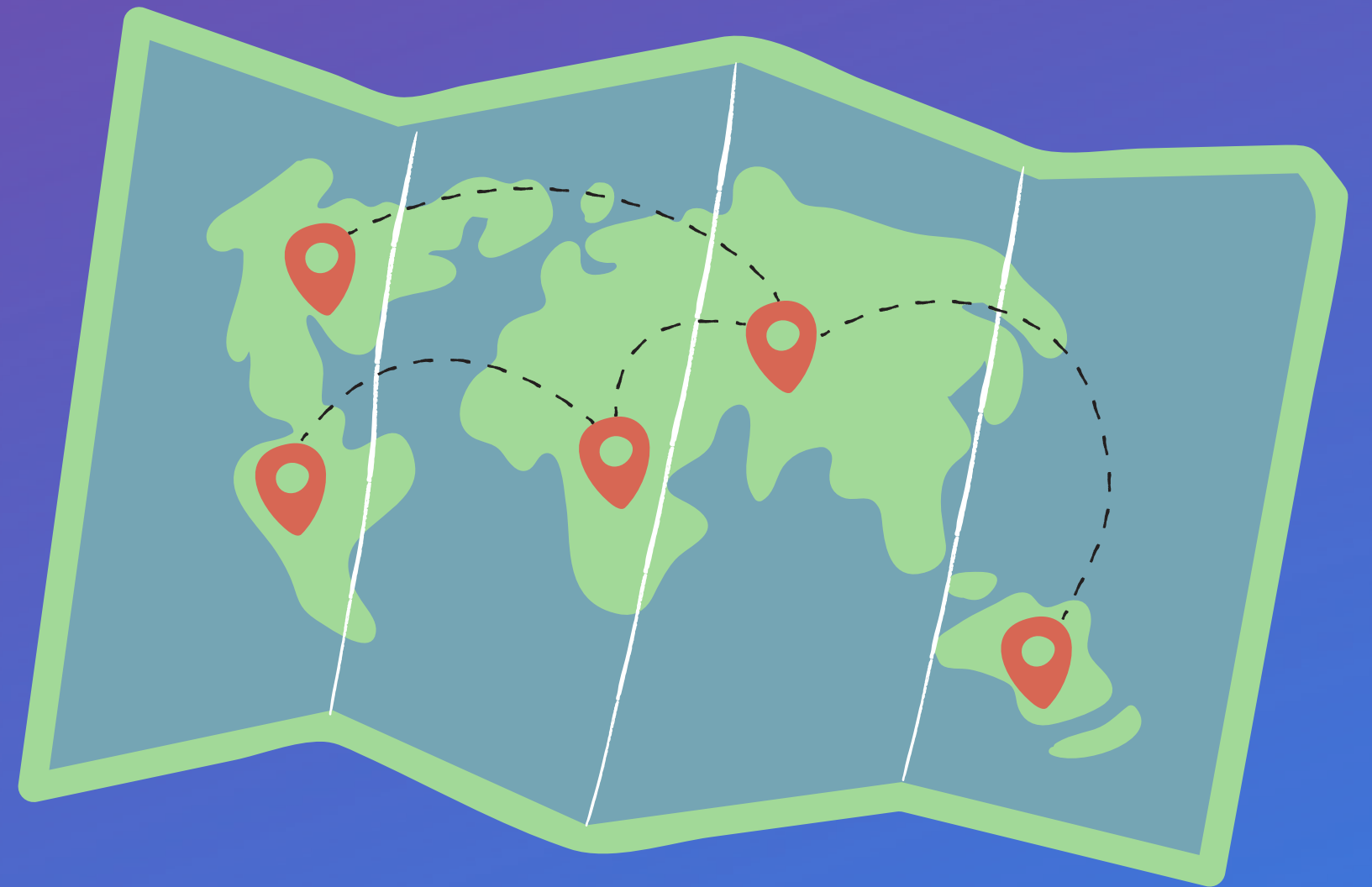
Science

In Science the children will be comparing a range of materials and discussing their properties. They will learn the difference between objects and materials and start to understand the importance of materials being suitable for the object to do its job.



Topic

Our whole school topic this term is 'Time Tunnel'. In History the children will be learning all about The Great Fire of London. They will learn about Samuel Pepys and the importance of his diary providing us with an insight as to what happened all those years ago!



RE

The children will be learning all about celebrations during special and sacred times.



Computing

In Computing the children will be learning all about programming. They will be giving BeeBots simple programming instructions such as forwards and backwards.



Music

In Music the children will be practicing their singing just in time for them to learn a range of traditional Christmas Carols.



PE
