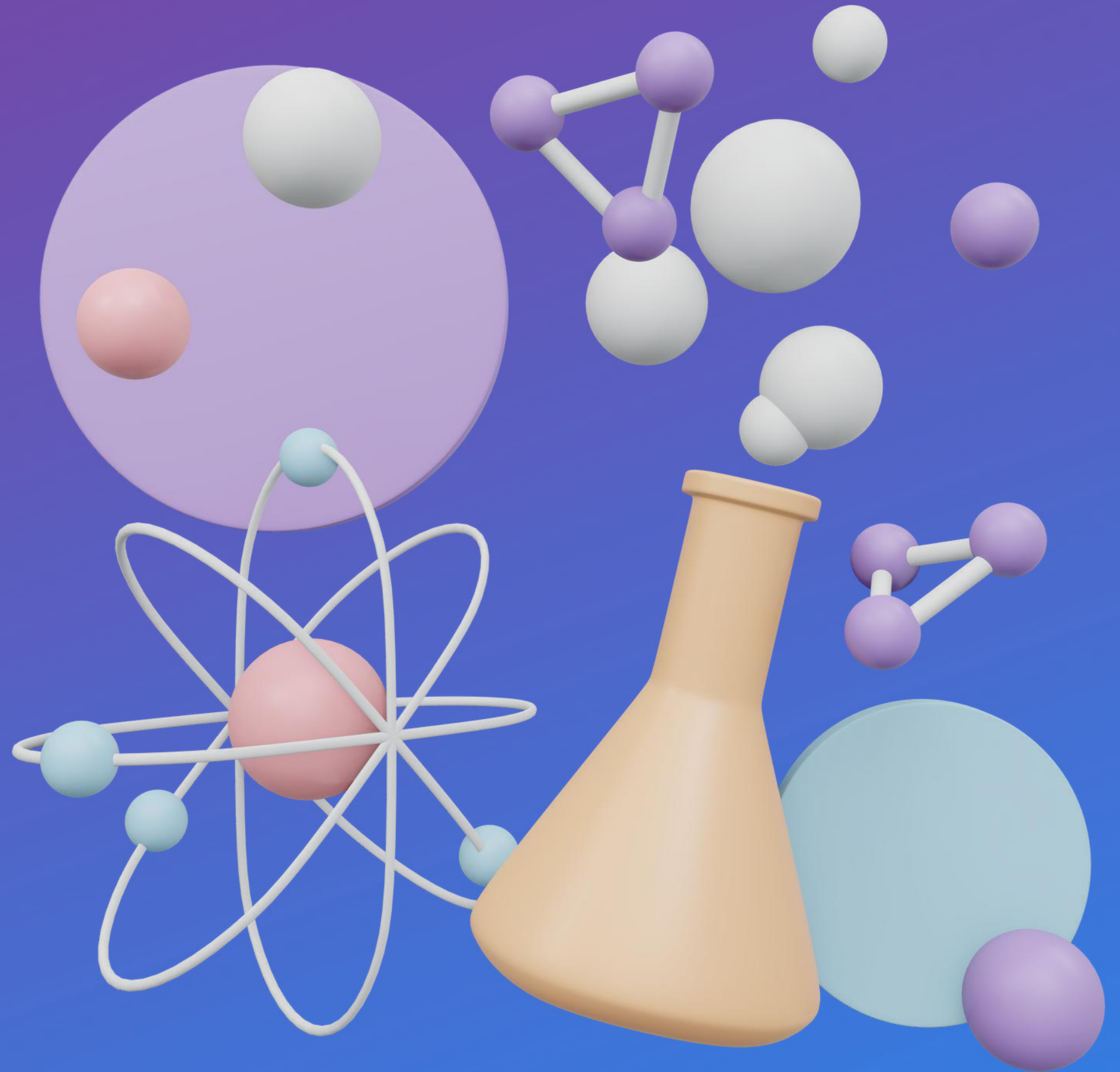
Maths

This term children will continue to develop their understanding of addition and subtraction. They will use manipulatives to partition numbers and demonstrate how with 2-digit numbers we add/subtract the ones, then the tens. Later in the term children will learn about shape and their properties. During the term, the children will continue to practice counting in 2s, 3s, 5s & 10s.



Science

Science is always exciting and the children will be continuing to learn about animals including humans. This term focuses on growth and we learn about a range of life cycles.



Topic

This is an exciting term for topic! First, children will discover the contribution Mary Seacole made to modern nursing and then compare her and the famous Lady with the lamp, Florence Nightingale.



RE

Children will learn about special and sacred times. They will think about the ways in which people celebrate., We will be thinking and talking about the Christmas story. We will consider the importance of light in faith.



Computing

Children will explore instructions and algorithms in computing. They will give instructions, follow a sequence of instructions and predict the outcome. We will be using the BeeBots and testing if our algorithms are accurate.



Music

In addition to learning songs and carols for our Christmas carol concert, children will be exploring rhythm and pulse.



PE

Jungle dance - children will move in a range of ways to music.

Ball skills – Children will learn a range of skills on how to throw, pass and move the ball with increasing control and co-ordination .
