



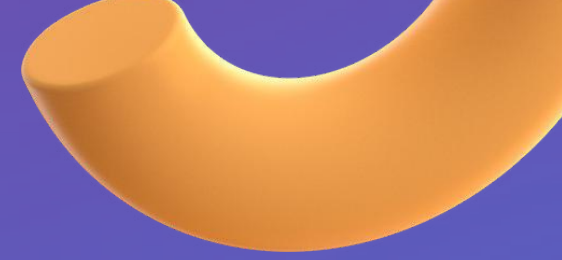
HOME AND AWAY

LITERACY

Maths

In Term 1, we will be reviewing the children's place value understanding and developing further onto numbers up to 1,000, 000. They will be rounding and ordering larger numbers along with problem solving and reasoning with these numbers. Children will move on to addition and subtraction with larger numbers and moving into answering calculations that involve decimals.



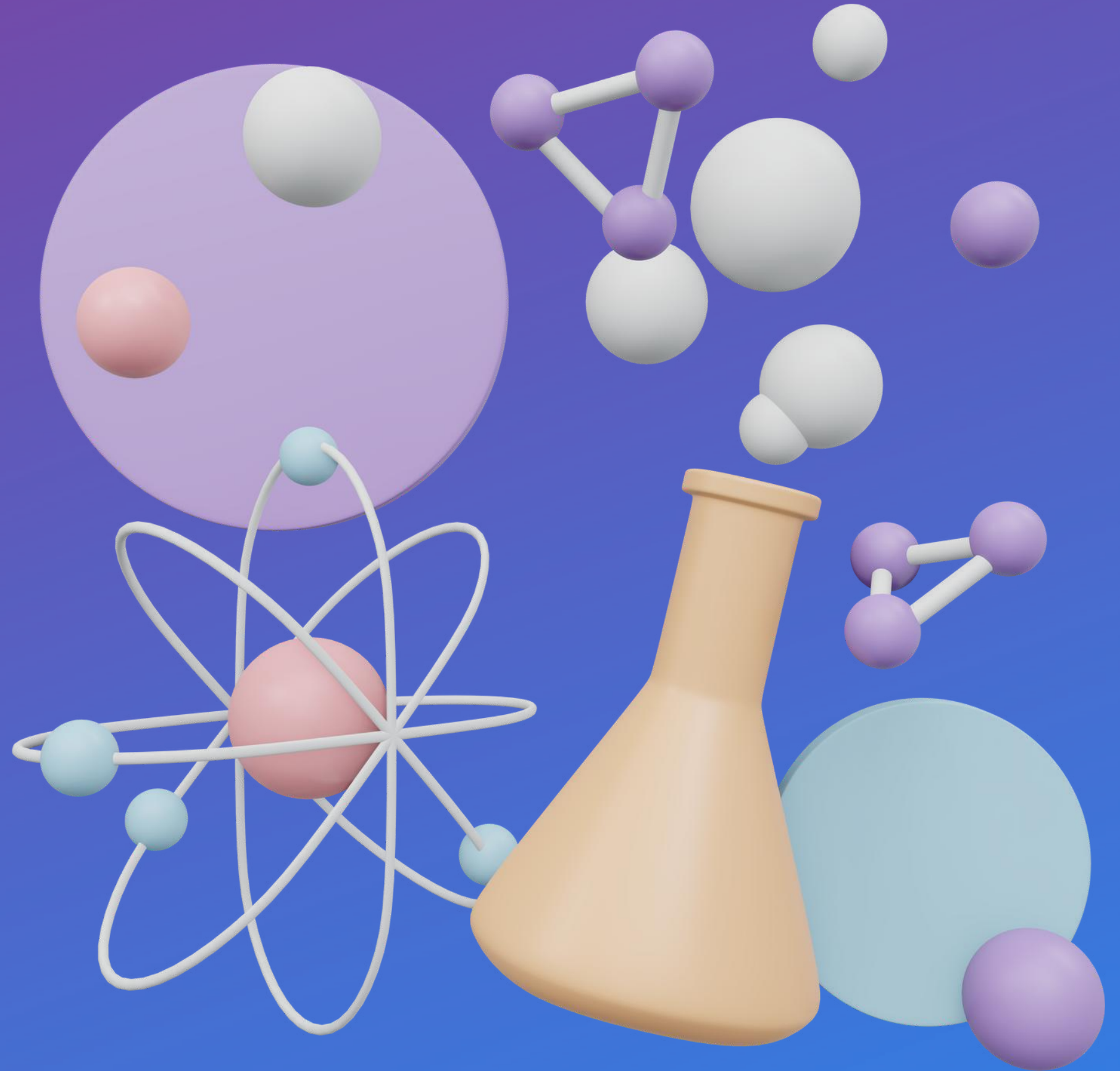
Homework

Science

The children will develop their understanding of changing materials. They will learn to test and sort a range of materials based on their physical properties and describe how some materials will dissolve and be retrieved.



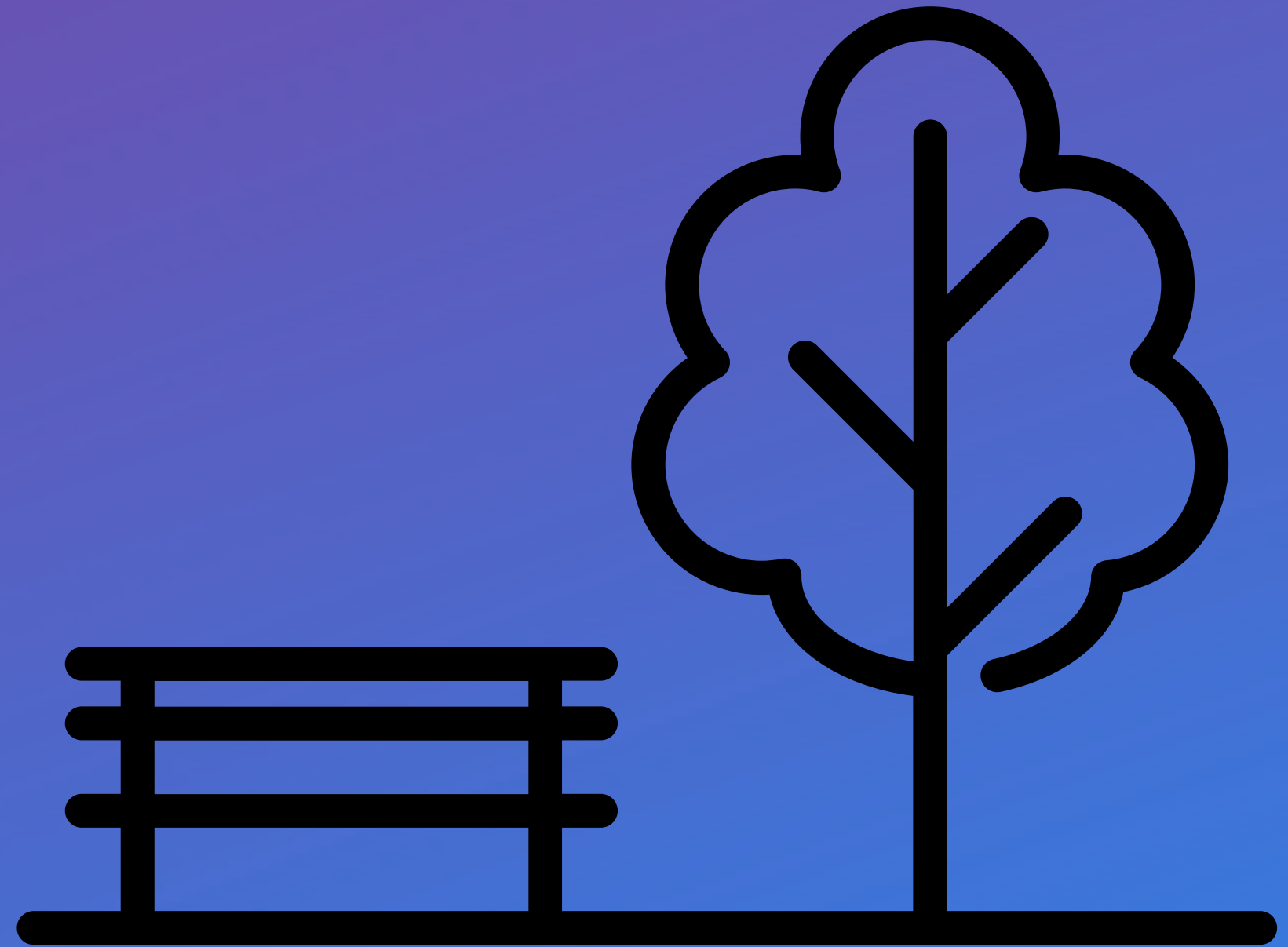
Topic

Children will expand their knowledge of the local area by exploring Faversham. We will think about our place in the world and then think about how Faversham has changed over time.



Art/DT

The children will find interesting features and views of a local area and then go on to study the work of some of the most famous landscape artists and how they use perspective to give a sense of depth to their work



PE

Indoor P.E

Year 5 are focusing on improving their overall fitness through a variety of engaging activities. Pupils will be taking part in circuit training, shuttle runs, skipping challenges, to build stamina and strength. They will also take part in agility-based games and bodyweight exercises designed to improve coordination and endurance, all while developing teamwork and resilience

Outdoor PE- Tag Rugby

The children will develop their skills in this sport including how to move, pass (whilst moving) and tackle with the ball.



Music

The children will be exploring sea shanties starting with 'What shall we do with the drunken sailor?' They will explore rhythm and beat using the cup song before moving on to body percussion.



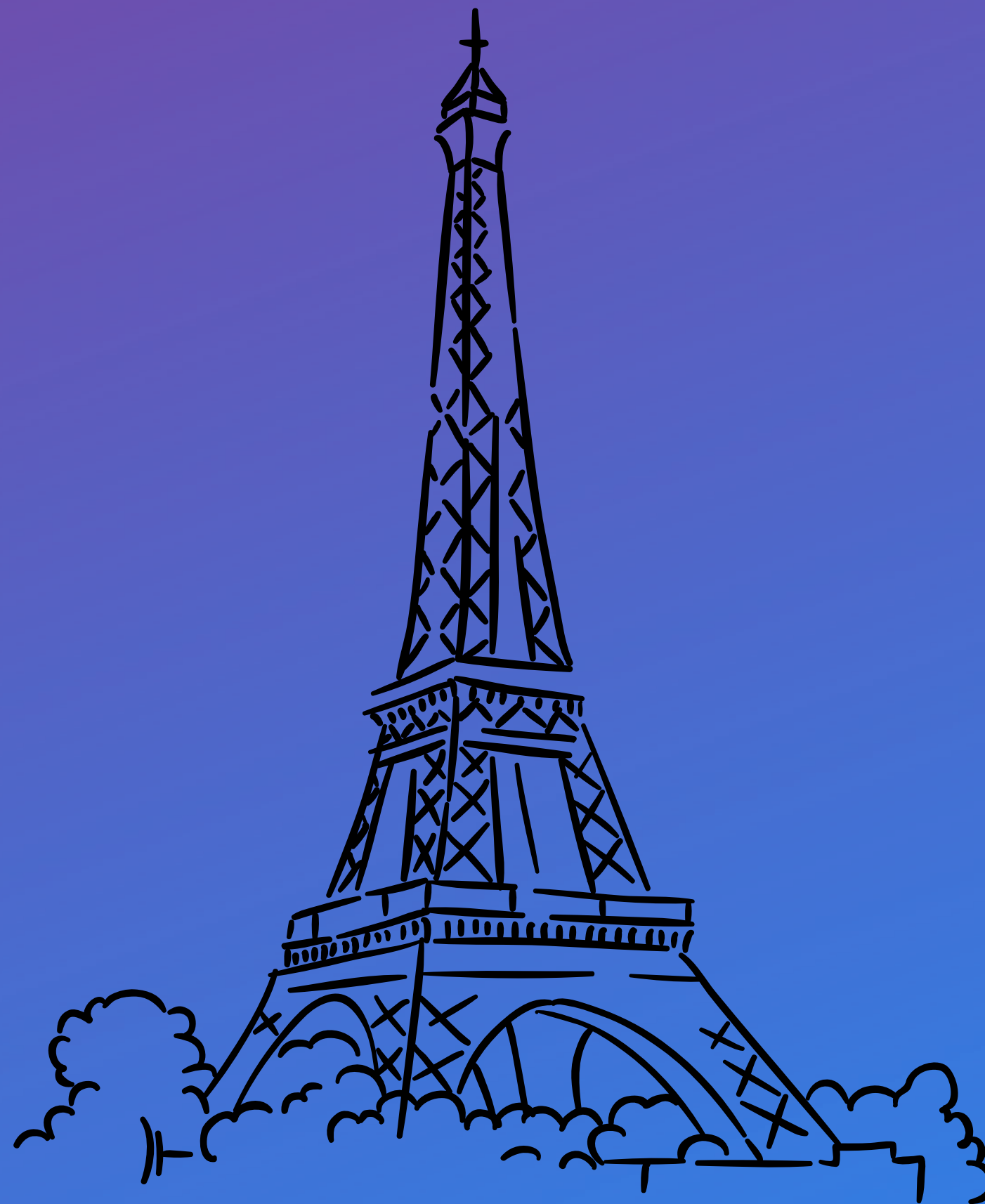
Computing
