

End of Key Stage Data 2024 - 2025 Sunny Bank Primary School At the end of Key Stage 2 in Year 6

At the end of Year 6, all children in England take standardised tests for Reading and Maths. Writing is assessed by teachers and moderated by the learning authority at a National standard.

We are proud of our children's hard work and their accelerated progress in these core subjects. The table below clearly demonstrates that our outcomes for Reading, Writing and Maths, both singularly and combined are above or closely aligned to the National average for schools.

For Writing and all subjects combined at the higher standard, our outcomes are also above or well above the national average. Data for higher standard for Reading and Maths was lower in 2025 and is indicative of cohort specific data.

KS2 Progress 2023 (there are no progress measures nationally for 2024)

Phonics % of children attaining the expected standard

At the end of Year 1 all children take a Phonics screener test. Our children's attainment for phonics is broadly in line with the National average. At the end of Year 2, children that did not pass the phonics screener test at the end of Year 1 will re-take the test.
