

End of Key Stage Data 2023 - 2024 Sunny Bank Primary School At the end of Key Stage 2 in Year 6

At the end of Year 6, all children in England take standardised tests for Reading and Maths. Writing is assessed by teachers and moderated by the learning authority at a National Standard.

We are proud of our children's hard work and their accelerated progress in these core subjects. The table below clearly demonstrates that our outcomes for Reading, Writing, Maths and the 3 subjects combined are well above the National average for schools.
