At the end of Key Stage 2 in Year 6, all children in England take standardised tests for Reading and Maths. Writing is teacher assessed and moderated by the learning authority at a National Standard.

The number of children that have an Educational Health Care Plan is well above average for the 2023 Year 6 cohort. Despite this our reading outcomes were well above average at the expected standard and well above average at the higher standard.
